

Steps for coordinating a successful program in your school:

ENSURE MILK IS AVAILABLE EVERY DAY AT LUNCH

- Designate a milk fridge
- · Establish milk delivery or pick up
- Determine how milk will be handed out

DETERMINE HOW STUDENTS WILL PARTICIPATE IN RECYCLING

- **Classroom collection** –each classroom will require a designated collection bin for recyclable beverage containers.
- Individual responsibility all students are responsible for recycling right.

COMMUNICATE PROGRAM INFO AND ENGAGE THE SUPPORT OF:

- **School administration** If needed, request support for engaging a Moo Crew to assist with making milk available, and recycling right.
- Custodial staff Discuss your school's recycling process, equipment (existing and provided), and program supports.
- Teachers and educational assistants Share how they can teach and encourage students to participate (share the Student/Classroom Participation Guide).
- Parents Announce your school's commitment to nutrition, leadership
 and recycling by sharing the Parent Info page. Download and share
 electronically through school communications.









INTRODUCE THE PROGRAM TO YOUR SCHOOL

- Determine how you will introduce the program to the school:
 - Assembly
 - Over the PA system
 - Brief presentation to each classroom
 - Classroom teachers

ORGANIZE A MOO CREW

- · Determine who the Moo Crew will be:
 - Existing or new leadership group
 - A particular grade or classroom(s)

SHARE AND CELEBRATE SUCCESS

(Optional, but highly recommended!)

- · Track recycling twice a year
- Use the **Measure Meter** (poster) to display results
- Use the Recycling Impact Calculator to determine the benefits of your school's efforts
- · Share your recycling results and success!
